An Important Message: Getting Vaccinated for COVID-19

People with intellectual disabilities are more likely to catch COVID-19 and to get very sick or die compared with other people. If you haven't already been vaccinated for COVID-19, it's important that you get an appointment as soon as you can. If you are worried about how the vaccine might affect you, you need to speak to your doctor to get the right advice.

We know that some people are finding it hard to work out how to get an appointment for a vaccination. Ask people you trust for help to get the information you need, and to get your vaccination. And if you can help other people get vaccinated, that's great too!

One way to get help is to contact a Disability Liaison Officer. They help people with a disability to book an appointment at a vaccination centre, or can organise for you to get a vaccination at home or in hospital.
