The Inclusive Community Development Network (ICDN) was set up to bring people with a disability and organisations together who are interested in sharing knowledge and information about their community development practice and the ways they are building more inclusive communities. The Network is supported and facilitated by the Victorian Advocacy League for Individuals with a Disability (VALID).

VALID has established Peer Action Groups (PAGS) in local communities across Victoria which are small local groups of people with disabilities who meet to share information about issues and aspirations and to work on community development projects and campaigns including the development of pathways to community leadership and influence.

The Network links the PAGs to a broader community of practice to help build some common understandings about the power of community development to position people with disabilities as leaders of social change.
