

Want to come to the Having a Say Conference?



Do you need support to attend the Having a Say Conference (HaS)?

It is a good idea to talk to your service and/or family about what support you need to attend.



You may need funding in your NDIS Plan to pay staff to support you, to travel and participate at HaS.



Having a Say is a community based self-advocacy skills and peer support development opportunity, so:

- Funding for staff support and transport can come from your Core Supports budget Core Supports 'camp' item 04_210_0125_6_1 and
- the registration fee can come from Core Supports: Self-Management Capacity Building Item 01_134_0117_8_1.



The other way that you can fund this capacity building activity is to:

- Ask your planner for '*Capacity Building Increased Social & Community Participation*' funding in your plan for skill development which can be funded under 'camps' [Price Guide item number 9_009_0117_6_3]
- Have this 'budget' either Plan Managed or Self-Managed in your Plan because you will need to pay organisations, including VALID, who are not NDIA registered agencies



Funding HaS through your NDIS plan is possible because Having a Say supports you to:

- Build skills and self-confidence through participating, volunteering, presenting, performing and learning heaps!
- Be inspired by peers
- Learn about rights and responsibilities
- Gain information on what support is available in both the community and disability services
