Registration Types

 Concession registration fees are for people who have Pension Concession Cards or a Health Care Cards



• **Early Bird** registration fee is only available before the 20th of May 2025



- Support workers do not pay a registration fee, only a catering fee of \$40 per day.
- Support Worker catering fee is available to workers or family members providing:
 - direct care, supervision, and/or
 - support, without which the participant with disability wouldn't be able to attend



Catering

- Lunch, morning and afternoon teas are provided
- Please advise of dietary requirements when you register



- Dietary needs due to medical conditions, medical allergies and disability needs will be provided
- Requests for special food that are purely 'likes and dislikes' or for weight loss are not provided



Cancellations and Refunds

- You can claim a **full refund** by emailing VALID up until 2nd of June 2025.
- After the 2nd of June 2025 there are no refunds, except in 'exceptional circumstances'.
