It is the question all parents have who is going to care for my family member when I'm not around?

VALID's Succession Planning course is for family members and carers of people with disability. The course is conducted **via Zoom** and covers the following areas:

- Mapping out what things you need to put in place to replace your roles e.g. nominee.
- Accommodation options and where to start or what to enhance.
- Legal and financial planning including Wills, Trusts etc.
- Setting up supports to ensure 'quality of care' when you are not around.
- Ensuring person has the right support to assist with decisions and not be left vulnerable to exploitation e.g. Supportive Attorneys, Guardianship, Administration?

Course Costs

The cost for an online group is \$640 (16 hrs x \$40) per person, which can be funded via 'Carer Training' in your family member's NDIS plan (Item number will be on the invoice). This includes copies of the session booklets and Word templates for planning.
