Advocacy in Action Conference 2026



Registration Types

- **Concession** registration fees are for people who have Pension Concession Cards or Health Care Cards



- **Early Bird** registration fee is only available up to (and including) the 15th of May 2026



- **Support workers** do not pay a registration fee, only a catering fee of \$40 per day



- **Support Worker** catering fee is available to workers or family members providing:
 - direct care, supervision, and/or
 - support, without which the participant with disability wouldn't be able to attend

Catering



- Lunch, morning and afternoon teas are provided
- If booked in to the social event at 4.30-5.30pm Monday 22nd June then nibbles and drinks included
- Please advise of dietary requirements when you register



- Dietary needs due to medical conditions, medical allergies and disability needs will be provided
- Requests for special food that are purely 'likes and dislikes' or for weight loss are not provided

Cancellations and Refunds



- Registration is not confirmed until payment is received
- If registrations are not paid **by the 15th of June**, they **will be cancelled**



- If you have paid, you can claim a **full refund** by emailing VALID before the 5th of June 2026
- After the 5th of June 2026 there are no refunds, except in 'exceptional circumstances'

- In case of emergency we need to be able to contact the Group Leader who is **at the conference**

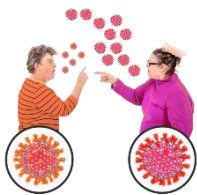


- An emergency might be someone becoming unwell

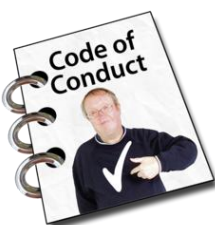
